Scorer Roles and Responsibilities

This month we focus on the role of the **Computer Scorer**.

Before the game:

1. Arrive at the ground at least 1½ hours before start of play for international matches (1 hour before all other games).
2. Capture the players' stats on the system.
3. Get the team lists as soon as they are made available by the teams.
4. Synchronise scoreboard clocks with the third umpire.

During the game:

1. Check totals with other scorers at the end of each over and at the fall of wicket.
2. Ensure scoreboard totals are correct.
3. Give additional stats/info to internet scorer, as and when required, throughout the game.

After the game:

1. Assist manual scorers with final stats.
2. Ensure computer is shut down properly.
