CSA CHANGES TO 2011/2012 COMPETITIONS

Cricket South Africa recently announced changes to the domestic cricket competitions for the 2011/2012 season.

The **MTN40** will now be a 45-overs-a-side competition to bring it more in line with the 50-over international format. We have not heard whether the substitution system tested during last season's MTN40, will once again be in place for next season. Teams will once again play each other at home and away.

A semi-professional side, drawn from the affiliated provinces, will join the **T20 competition** as a seventh team. This team will be allowed to sign four foreign players of whom a maximum of three can be selected for any one T20 game. This side will have no home venue but will use the High Performance Centre in Pretoria as their base.

The six franchise teams will each be allowed to recruit two foreign players for the T20 competition which will now be played over a double round of fixtures.

Twenty-over matches will also be introduced at first class (**Provincial**) level. Three-day matches will continue, with a mix of 40-over and 20-over matches played on the fourth day.

More detailed Playing Conditions will be circulated in due course.

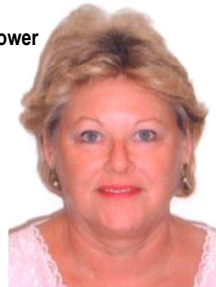
